This price report provides state-wide average prices for standing timber (stumpage) for pine, oak, and mixed hardwood sawtimber, pine chip-n-saw, and pine and hardwood pulpwood. Timber prices may vary greatly depending on many factors to include: location, species, products, access and distance to mill. These values may not reflect the stumpage values for a particular stand of trees or with in a specific region of the state.
