Price - Price information is from Timber Mart-South Volume 30, 2005. Publication compiled and produced at the Daniel B. Warnell School of Forest Resources, University of Georgia, under contract with the Frank W. Norris Foundation, a non-profit corporation. Price information for hardwood sawtimber and hardwood pulpwood are based on average values for mixed hardwoods. Hardwood veneer price is based on the maximum value reported for oak sawtimber.
