**Ownership Class**

Private Ownership is both non-industrial private forestland and industrial forestland

Public ownership includes all county, state, and federal public land

**Income Estimates**

Income estimates are determined by multiply average yearly prices against the most recent harvest data that is available.

Price - Price information is from Timber Mart-South Volume 31, 2006. Publication compiled and produced at the Daniel B. Warnell School of Forest Resources, University of Georgia, under contract with the Frank W. Norris Foundation, a non-profit corporation. Price information for hardwood sawtimber and hardwood pulpwood are based on average values for mixed hardwoods. Hardwood veneer price is based on the maximum value reported for oak sawtimber.

Data is collected by USFS through State Surveys. Most recent data available is 2003.
