

# North Carolina Standing Timber Price Report


This price report provides state-wide average prices for standing timber (stumpage) for pine, oak, and mixed hardwood sawtimber, pine chip-n-saw, and pine and hardwood pulpwood. This information is made possible through an agreement with Timber Mart-South (www.timbermart-south.com). Timber prices may vary greatly depending on many factors to include: location, species, products, access and distance to mill. These values may not reflect the stumpage values for a particular stand of trees or with in a specific region of the state. 

### Quarterly stumpage price trend


### Hardwood Sawtimber price trend (\$/ton)

# Conversion Factors

### Pine

Sawtimber (tons/1000 bd. Ft.) 7.5 Chip-n-saw (tons/1000 bd. ft.) 7.5 pulpwood/chip-n-saw (tons/st. cord) 2.68

#### Hardwood

Sawtimber (tons/1000 bd. Ft.) 8.75 pulpwood/chip-n-saw (tons/st. cord) 2.9
