How to Make Simple Nature Journal


Materials: needed for each journal

- 10 sheets of regular 8 ½ x 11 copy paper
- Hole punch
- Yarn, twine or string
 - 1 rubber band
 - Stick, bamboo skewer, or pencil
- Stickers, markers, etc. to decorate journal cover



Instructions:

- 1. Fold the copy paper in half (hamburger style) so it is now 8 ½ x 5 inches
- 2. Punch two holes along the folded edge of the paper equal distances from the top and bottom edge.



Binding Option 1 – String, Yarn, or Twine

- 3. Cut two 6-inch pieces of string, twine, or yarn
- 4. Lace the string through the holes and tie (see example to the right)

Binding Option 2 – Rubber bands and Stick, Skewer, or Pencil

- 5. Put loop end of rubber band through hole
- 6. Slide stick, skewer, or pencil through the loop
- 7. Put the other end loop of rubber band through other hole
- 8. Slide free end of stick, skewer, or pencil through the loop (see example below)
- 9. Decorate front cover of journal with markers, stickers, etc.
