

North Carolina Project Learning Tree 2022 Summary

NC PLT by the Numbers

21 Facilitators, representing 17 organizations, led 21 Workshops across the state 383 Educators trained

477 PLT Activity Guides and online training codes distributed through workshops = **\$9810** in support from NC Forestry Association

NC PLT partners contributed \$3,294 in material support of the program and \$8,573 contributed time* to lead workshops; a total contribution of \$11,867 from statewide partners

13 K-8 workshops, 2 K-12 workshops, 6 Early Childhood workshops

- Completely transitioned to new *Explore You Environment* (K-8) and *Trees and Me* (early childhood) guides
- 13 workshops held at higher education institutions; 2 workshops in partnership with whole schools

2021 = 24 workshops, 17 facilitators, 384 trained

Other Items of Note

- Virtual Facilitator Training in February; 10 new facilitators, 3 seasoned facilitators
- Coordinator and Co-Coordinator attended the joint SFI/PLT Conference
- Three total conference presentations/exhibits, Environmental Educators of North Carolina and the NC Science Teachers Association
- Another facilitator training will be held (in-person), in early 2023
- Correlations will be updated when NC Science standards are updated
- Continue work on how to promote Green Jobs materials
- 2023 is gearing up to be another big year for early childhood demand based on inquiries
