
Elm zigzag sawfly (*Aproceros leucopoda*) detections in the United States



The elm zigzag sawfly is an invasive defoliating pest of trees in the Ulmaceae family. Native to Asia, it was detected in Canada in 2020 and in Virginia in 2021. USDA-APHIS is the federal identifier that confirms all county-level detections for the elm zigzag sawfly. This map includes all APHIS confirmations in addition to detections pending APHIS confirmation to better inform the known range of this invasive insect.
